1. The exhibit will be held in the Blue Exhibition Building at the Fair Grounds on Plains Road in Augusta, NJ

2. All handiwork, canned goods, and wine must be presented Saturday July 25, 2009 between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. and Sunday July 26, 2009 from 12 noon to 5:00 p.m. See *separate directions for beer entries*.

3. Baked goods exhibits must be presented on disposable crockery by 9:00 a.m. Thursday, August 6th 2009 and must enter the grounds via GATE 1 **or you will be required to pay entrance fee**. Recipes must be included for all items. Judging to begin at 10:00 a.m. Pre-registration recommended.

4. **No exhibit shall be removed before 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 9th, 2009, but must be removed before 7:30 p.m. SHARP!** All entries that remain after 7:30 p.m. become the property of the **Creative Arts for Home and Hobby Division**. Only in case of adverse conditions forcing the legal closing of the entire Fair will earlier return of entries be permitted. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

5. Entry is open to all residents of New Jersey; all ages are welcome. **All entries must be in specific categories. If under 18, please indicate on entry blank so entry may be judged within age group Teen 13-17, Adolescent 9-12, Child under 9**

6. **A \$2 entry fee PER PERSON will be required in Handicrafts, Canning, and Baking, Categories. Classes 33, 34 & 35 are exempt from fee. ANY ENTRY IN ANY CATEGORY BY A TEEN, ADOLESCENT, OR CHILD IS ALSO EXEMPT.**

7. Acceptance of entries will be at the discretion of the Committee.

8. No exhibit will be accepted with the exhibitor's name exposed.
9. All entries must be in the number required. Three entries are allowed each **exhibitor** in each class with the exception of baked goods in which one entry is allowed in each class.
10. Canned goods preserved since August 2008 are eligible.
11. Canned goods must be exhibited in identical, standard-sized jars with two-piece lids and must have the ring on each jar. Jars must not be sealed with paraffin. Include recipes and processing methods used on file card, attached to one jar.
12. Labels on canned goods should have the name of the contents first, then the date; no exhibitor's names.
13. The Committee designates a professional as one whom:
 - a. teaches or judges in a specific craft now or in the past,
 - b. sells, designs or has sold a specific craft or item,
 - c. exhibits commercially and/or is published.

Professionals will not be judged with non-professionals. - **ONE MUST NOTE PROFESSIONAL STATUS ON THE ENTRY BLANK!**

14. Articles previously entered may not be exhibited again.
15. Only articles completed within the last three (3) years will be accepted. Articles must be clean and presentable.
16. No article for which there is an existing class may be exhibited in the Miscellaneous class. Four or more like items may be judged as a separate group within the Miscellaneous class.
17. Exhibitor must have picture or other appropriate articles securely framed and prepared for hanging. All items will be accepted and arranged for display at the discretion of the Committee.
18. ALL ribbons will be awarded at the discretion of the judges.
