### EYE PROTECTION REQUIRED FOR ALL EVENTS

#### ~ Wood Chopping ~

1. No restrictions are placed on the type and size of ax. The contestant may have as many axes as he wishes and may supply blocks and nails to secure the 8" x 8" block
2. Open to men only.

#### ~ Log Rolling Contest ~

1. Two person team must propel a log resting against two stakes in the ground a distance of 30 feet to a second set of stakes using cant hooks or peaveys only.
2. The log must contact both stakes at the far end of the field at the same time and must then come to rest against the first pair to finish.
3. Hands and feet maybe used. Fastest team wins.
4. Men & Women's Divisions

#### ~ Two Person Crosscut Saw Contest ~

1. Two complete sections must be cut from a 8" square log with a 6" marked space.
2. Fastest team wins
3. Open to Men Only

#### ~ Wood Splitting Contest ~

1. Each Contestant will be given three pieces of wood, each approximately 2' long with a 3" dot painted in the center. Each piece must be split into 4 pieces, each having a portion of the dot on it.
2. Contestants will supply their own splitting mauls. No restrictions will be placed on the design of the maul.
3. Open to Men Only

#### ~ Chain Saw Contest ~

1. Wood to be used will be 8" x 8"
2. Three cuts required in 6" marked space; one down, one up and one down
3. All saws must be unmodified. No exotic fuels

4. Times will begin event with the saws off and on the ground. Saw must be started on the ground at the signal.
5. There will be three classes
  - i) Small class 0-3.5CI
  - ii) Medium Class 3.6 – 4.7CI
  - iii) Large Class 4.8 and above
6. No hot saws allowed – Men Only
7. Eye protection, hardhat and chaps required
8. Men & Women's Divisions

### ~ Log Felling ~

1. Time will start with saw not running
2. Contestants will be judged on how accurate the fall is. In case of a tie, the judges will make the final decision.
3. Top five competitors to compete

### ~ Awards ~

Ribbon awards

Overall Woodsman's and Woodswomen Trophy for highest point count

Eye protection, Hard Hats and Chaps will be provided if necessary.
