2011 RULES AND REGULATIONS 2011

The Nation-Wide Demolition Derby is promoted as an unusual spectator attraction. In the interest of safety, Drivers and Mechanics are subject to, and must obey, the following rules and regulations which are set up by the promoter and the track where this event is being held:

- A. Each driver must fill out an entry blank. All drivers must supply their own cars, **only one entry per person per class**. Proof of ownership may be required on each car entered.
- B. **All drivers and/or pit persons 16 or 17 years of age must have a notarized release signed by his or her parent or guardian. Nobody under 16 years of age can drive or be in the pit area.** 17
- C. **The track or promoter reserves the right to approve or reject any and all entries.**
- D. All persons must sign the release sheet and receive a pit pass to be permitted in the pit area or on the track. **Drivers only to receive free pit pass** upon registration of a car on day of the show. **All other pit passes are \$10.00 each UNLESS NOTED. \$15.00**
- E. **No drinking** of alcoholic beverages on track, emergency vehicle area or in the pit area. Any driver or pit person under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be immediately disqualified and removed from the grounds.
- F. **Any driver or crew member disobeying the rules will cause his or her car to be disqualified.** Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and will be grounds for disqualification and barring from future derbies. Drivers are responsible for the actions of their crew members.
- G. Contestants of the Nation-Wide Demolition Derby are not employees of Nation-Wide Demolition Derby. Nation-Wide Demolition Derby will not be responsible for any damage caused by driver's negligence on the track or in the pit area. "Drivers and pit personnel are responsible for any damage caused by their negligence on the track or in the pit area."
- H. The promoter, track owner or fair association will not be held responsible for any cars, parts or personal property before, during and after the show or overnight.
- I. **Car and driver must sign in at registration desk at least one hour prior to show time or a \$10.00 fine will be imposed for late arrivals.**

TOWING AND TRANSPORTING CARS

- 1. Towing and transporting Demolition Derby cars to and from race locations must meet highway safety codes (including proper light controls, safety chains, tow bars, towing trailers, etc.)

American Made

TYPE OF CAR

- 1. Any hardtop automobile or **station wagon** is allowed. No Chrysler Imperials, limousines, convertibles, jeep or hearses are allowed. Compact cars must be 104 inch wheel base or less and 4 cylinders, 6 cylinder class must be 108 inches or less wheel base and 4 or 6 cylinders. No AMC's in the compact class. Trucks have a different set of rules when permitted to run. 6 cylinder and truck classes to be run on limited dates and will be listed on entry blanks.

PREPARATION OF CAR

(Remove following before arriving at fairgrounds or track.)

- 1. **All glass** including windshield, side windows, rear window, head and tail lights. **Rolling windows down is not permitted.**
- 2. **Auto must be swept clean. No junk tires, wheels, metal parts, broken glass, etc. allowed in car.**
- 3. Chrome moulding strips and the bottom portion of rear seats must be removed. On station wagons all rear seats and deck lids must be removed. All fiberglass or plastic front header panels must be removed.
- 4. Any sharp protruding fins or dangerous objects (mash down or cut off).
- 5. No special bumpers, reinforcements or trailer hitches permitted. Fenders and bumper ends may be trimmed to allow for wheel clearance. On late model, shock bumper may be lightly welded or short piece of chain from bolt on bumper to bolt on frame.
- 6. Suspension **MUST** remain **STRICTLY STOCK**. Do not crank up torsion bar suspension on Chrysler Corp. cars. All cars **MUST** have some give or bounce. No stiff suspension. Screw in spring risers or blocks may be allowed at the discretion of the officials to bring weak or sagging suspensions to level position, bring such items to the track and obtain permission before installation.
- 7. Rear coil spring cars and station wagons that change to shackles and springs, must use maximum of (5) (Five) stock leafs on sedans and station wagons. No truck springs. Maximum of 4 clamps per spring, two back are permitted. Spring leafs must be stair-stepped in length and not the same length as the main leaf. All compact and 6 cylinder class cars must use original springs.
- 8. Welded solid or chained down engine mounts are recommended. Body mount bolts may be replaced, but only with stock size bolts (no larger than 5/8" and only (1) round washer.)
- 9. No 3/4 ton rear ends.

10. Radiators must remain in original position or be taken off. Comparable replacement radiators are permitted. Radiators and cooling systems should be flushed of anti-freeze and only water added. Transmission coolers are permitted but **ONLY** if they are secured inside the engine compartment or backseat area covered in a concealed unit.
11. Dash bars are permitted across front from driver's door to passenger door for driver's safety.
12. All doors must be fastened shut by wire, straps, chains, or welded and reinforced for the driver's safety. It is recommended the driver's door be reinforced inside with a steel bar, angle iron, or pipe not to exceed 6" beyond front door and not beyond rear axle. Doors may be welded with strapping not to exceed 2" wide. Also, no strap welding will be permitted on station wagon tailgates. Decision of the officials is final on welding.
13. **ONLY ONE BATTERY**, any size, is allowed. Battery must be moved from original position, and placed on floorboard of driver's compartment and securely fastened and covered.
14. Hood, trunk or tailgate may be wired in six (6) places each, 2 strands of wire per hole. Light chains may be used on trunk or tailgate only. Wiring must be from sheet metal to sheet metal. No other wiring to bumpers or frames. No bands, bolts, pins or cable can be used. **NO WELDS ON HOOD, TRUNK OR TAILGATE.** Official's decision on over use of wire or chains. **HOODS AND TRUNK MUST BE LEFT OPEN UNTIL AFTER INSPECTION. HOODS MUST REMAIN ON CARS, IF HOODS ARE REMOVED, FAN BLADES MUST ALSO BE REMOVED.**
15. **IT IS NO LONGER PERMITTED TO MASH DOWN THE REAR SECTION OF ANY VEHICLE.**
16. **BOTH FRONT DOORS MUST BE PAINTED WHITE FOR NUMBERING.** Special numbers are permitted. **NO PROFANITY WILL BE ALLOWED ON ANY PORTION OF CAR.**
17. **STOCK GAS TANKS MUST BE REMOVED FROM ORIGINAL POSITION AND MUST BE PLACED IN REAR SEATING AREA, NOT IN TRUNK AREA;** all tanks must be securely fastened to floor and covered; a portable tank is recommended in place of the original. **(NO PLASTIC TANKS) GAS LINES AND FITTINGS TO FUEL TANKS MUST BE SECURED AND LEAK PROOF.** Only metal or rubber gas lines permitted. **(NO PLASTIC LINES!)** Maximum four (4) gallons of gas permitted per heat. Electric fuel pumps are permitted, but **MUST** have a shut-off switch within drivers reach. Inspection official will give final approval on tanks and fittings.
18. Each driver and mechanics must **SIGN IN** at registration desk the day of the show and have their car **INSPECTED** at least **ONE HOUR** prior to show time.
19. **IT IS MANDATORY THAT AN OPENING BE CUT IN HOOD COVER OVER THE CARBURETOR**, approximately 8" or larger, square or diameter. **HOOD LATCHES MUST BE REMOVED.** Also recommended that a hole should be cut in middle of trunk lid for visibility.
20. **NO RESTRICTIONS ON TIRE SIZE. NO STUDS OR SCREWS IN RIMS TO HOLD TIRES. NO VALVE STEM PROTECTORS. NO SPLIT RIMS. WHEEL WEIGHTS MUST BE REMOVED.**
21. **A STRONG WIRE OR NYLON MESH SCREEN IS RECOMMENDED ON DRIVER'S WINDOWS AND WINDSHIELD AREA. PLEXIGLAS IS PERMITTED IN DRIVER'S WINDSHIELD AREA. IT IS MANDATORY THAT A CHAIN, STRONG WIRE OR STRAP BE SECURED FROM THE CENTER OF ROOF TO DASH FOR A CENTER POST TO STOP HOOD FROM COMING THROUGH FRONT WINDOW.**

RUNNING

1. **Safety belt, D.O.T. approved helmet, goggles, safety glasses or face shields are required.** Long pants and shirts or jackets are required.
2. **No** deliberate head-on collisions and no deliberate hitting on the driver's door.
3. Vehicles must have dependable brakes at all times and boundaries must be observed.
4. **No** cars are permitted in the competition area before the heat in which they are to participate.
5. **A vehicle will be disqualified if ANY door comes open during the heat.**
6. One minute limit is enforced by the track officials for re-starts and making competitive contact with another car. Hits must be aggressive. Simple contact within the time limit does not constitute combat and could be considered sandbagging.
7. All cars are to be removed from the fairgrounds or race track following the show or they will become the property of NATION-WIDE Demolition Derby and the officials will have them removed (unless otherwise specified at the driver's meeting). A removal deposit may be required in some areas.
8. **A driver's \$100.00 protest fee is required to contest another car. Fee will be refunded if car is found to be ineligible. Protest must be done before drivers meeting.**
9. **No** one riding on outside of cars anytime due to insurance regulation.

(Additional safety regulations may be imposed, depending on track.)

Boundaries must be observed at all times. Any car shoved or driven out of bounds or is on or over a pole may be immediately disqualified if Derby officials feel it's a **SAFETY HAZARD.**

The Derby will be composed of individual heats and one Feature, with cash prizes going to the winners of each heat and grand prize going to winner of the Feature. Decision of the official is final.

These rules supersede any, and all rules previously used.

Subchapter 9. Demolition Derby and Tractor Pulls

13:62-9.1 Demolition derby vehicles

- (a) In a demolition derby event, any stock, American made; hardtop automobile may be used.
- (1) American made and foreign made, stock, hardtop vehicles may participate together in a Compact Car Class with the following guidelines:
- Vehicles must have four (4) cylinder engines.
 - A maximum wheelbase of 104" measured from center of front wheel to center of rear wheel.
 - Vehicles shall not have more than five (5) lug nuts per wheel.
 - Wheel size not to exceed 15 inches.
 - No full framed vehicles allowed.
 - Compact cars will not compete with any other class.
- (b) In a demolition derby event, jeeps, carryalls, station wagons, ambulances, and other vehicles utilizing a truck chassis are not permitted.
- (c) All glass, including rear windows, headlights, taillights, and parking lights, must be removed with the exception of the windshield. If the windshield is removed it must be replaced with heavy mesh screening with a center post or plexiglass.
- (d) All chrome strips must be removed from a participating vehicle.
- (e) Gas tanks may be moved to a different position within the driving compartment. Tanks relocated into the driver compartment must be placed in the vehicle where the back seat normally would be located, on the right side behind the front passenger seat. All tanks shall be constructed of steel (22 gauge minimum) or aluminum (16 gauge minimum). Tanks shall be restricted to a maximum capacity of five gallons. Tanks shall be encased in a metal box that is bolted to the floor of the vehicle. The box shall have a metal lid that is fastened to the container. A metal fire wall must be between the driver and the gas tank.
- (f) Fuel lines and pumps will not be allowed in the driving compartment.
- (g) All doors must be securely fastened by either welding, metal strips, or chains.
- (h) Doors opening during an event will automatically disqualify that automobile.
- (i) Batteries located within the driver compartment must have a suitable cover and be securely fastened.
- (j) All vehicles must be equipped with a securely installed safety belt.
- (k) Rear seats must be removed from a participating vehicle.
