Open Poultry Show

Health Regulations

- All birds must have an official CVI, HC, or VS Form 9-2 or 9-3
- All birds (excluding waterfowl) must test negative to Pullorum-typhoid within 30 days prior to the exhibit.
- All birds under 4 months of age shall originate from Pullorum-typhoid negative flocks. (The individual test is not valid for birds in this age group.)

New Jersey State Law Requirements: New Jersey Law requires Pullorum/typhoid testing within 30 days of exhibit in order to show or sell birds. BE PREPARED TO HAVE YOUR BIRDS CHECKED FOR PULLORUM CERTIFICATES. WATERFOWL ARE EXEMPT. All county fairs are under the auspices of New Jersey Department of Agriculture. State inspectors will be present on the fairgrounds.

NEW JERSEY POULTRY Attending a New Jersey Fair/Show:

- Shall be accompanied by an official CVI, AHC, VS Form 9-2 or 9-3, or a 4-H Poultry, Rabbit, or Cavy Health Form
- All poultry, including exhibition, exotic, and game birds (including ostrich, emu and rhea but excluding waterfowl) going to public exhibitions in New Jersey shall originate from U.S. Pullorum-Typhoid clean or equivalent flocks, OR All poultry over 4 months of age shall have an individual Pullorum-Typhoid test within 90 days prior to the exhibit.
 - Turkeys shall be blood tested at more than 12 weeks of age
 - Game birds shall be tested when more than 4 months of age or upon reaching sexual maturity, whichever comes first
 - Ostrich, emu, rhea and cassowaries shall be blood tested when more than 12 months of age. All ostrich, emus, rhea and cassowaries less than twelve months shall originate from Pullorum-Typhoid negative flocks.
 - All birds less than four months of age shall originate from Pullorum-Typhoid negative flocks (the individual test is not valid for birds in this age group)

IMPORTED POULTRY Attending a New Jersey Fair/Show:

- Shall be accompanied by an official CVI or VS Form 9-2 or 9-3
- All poultry, including exhibition, exotic, and game birds (including ostrich, emu and rhea but excluding waterfowl) shall originate from U.S. Pullorum-Typhoid clean or equivalent flocks, OR all poultry over 4 months of age shall have an individual Pullorum-Typhoid test within 90 days prior to the exhibit. See testing information below:
 - Turkeys shall be blood tested at more than 12 weeks of age
 - Game birds shall be tested when more than 4 months of age or upon reaching sexual maturity, whichever comes first.
 - Ostrich, emu, rhea and cassowaries shall be blood tested when more than 12 months of age. All ostrich, emus, rhea and cassowaries under twelve months shall originate from Pullorum-Typhoid negative flocks.
- All birds less than four months of age shall originate from Pullorum-Typhoid negative flocks (the individual test is not valid for birds in this age group).
- All poultry and hatching eggs originating from areas or counties with confirmed cases of Avian Influenza must obtain a permit number for entry. This number must appear on the original health certificate or VS Form 9-2 or 9-3 issued by an accredited veterinarian. Permits may be obtained by contacting the New Jersey Department of Agriculture, Division of Animal Health, at (609) 292-3965, Monday-Friday, 8:45 a.m.-4:45 p.m.

Please note: Concerns regarding Avian Influenza virus continue. In order to protect the State's poultry industry, the NJDA recommends that the fair/show management adopt rules that require all poultry and hatching eggs to be exhibited be accompanied by certification that they are free from Avian Influenza, regardless of where the birds originated.

Special notice for all poultry exhibitors

All live birds and hatching eggs of any avian species entering New Jersey must obtain a permit for entry that will appear on the original health certificate issued by an accredited veterinarian. For questions regarding this or to obtain a permit, contact the New Jersey Department of Agriculture, Division of Animal Health, at (609) 292-3965, Monday - Friday, 8:45 am - 4:45 pm.

If other emergency conditions, including outbreaks of certain infectious diseases, warrant additional restrictions on any species of animals moving into and/or through the state, additional emergency rules may be enacted and all fair and show managers will be notified.

All poultry and hatching eggs originating from those designated areas or counties with confirmed cases of Avian Influenza must obtain a prior permit for entry that will appear on the original health certificate or VS Form 9-2 or 9-3 issued by an accredited veterinarian. Permits may be obtained by contacting the New Jersey Department of Agriculture, Division of animal Health at (609) 292-3965, Monday-Friday, 8:45 a.m. – 4:45 p.m.

2. Entry Fee is \$2.00 per bird.

3. There will be one free weekly pass provided per mailing address exhibiting a minimum of two birds. If needed, additional weekly passes may be purchased for \$10 each for any other entrants from that mailing address exhibiting two or more additional birds. Please include payment with entry form. There will be a \$28.00 charge for checks not honored by the exhibitor's bank.

4. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED ON OR BEFORE JULY 13th TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR \$2 PER BIRD FEE. THOSE POSTMARKED JULY 14-19th MUST PAY A \$4 PER BIRD FEE. NO ENTRIES POST-MARKED AFTER JULY 19th WILL BE ACCEPTED. Entries must be received by July 20th.**

5. The show hall will open Friday, August 6th from 11:00am. All entries must be cooped by Saturday, August 7th at 10:00am.

6. **LIMITED TO THE FIRST 300 BIRD ENTRIES AND/OR POSTMARK. ALL ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY APPLICATION, OR THEY WILL BE RETURNED. PLEASE FILL OUT ENTRY FORM COMPLETELY.**

7. ENTRIES MUST REMAIN ON DISPLAY UNTIL SUNDAY, AUGUST 15TH AT 4:00 pm UNLESS RELEASED BY THE FARM & HORSE SHOW COMMITTEE. (Certain circumstances may apply).

8. Judging will take place on Sunday, August 8th at 10:00am. The show will be conducted under the latest revised standards of the APA/ABA. **The show will be APA/ABA sanctioned.**

9. **Premiums:** 1st place-\$5.00; 2nd place-\$4.00; 3rd place-\$3.00; Grand Champion Poultry-\$30.00; Reserve Champion Poultry-\$25.00; Champion Large/Bantam/Standard Duck/ Bantam Duck/ Goose/Turkey/and Pigeon-\$20.00; Reserve Champion Large/Bantam/Standard Duck/ Bantam Duck/ Goose/Turkey/and Pigeon -\$15.00; Artie Passafaro Memorial Trophy-Champion Bird

10. We are asking that anyone wishing to show; help keep the barn clean by sweeping and picking up and by helping to water birds, on a daily basis. See Show Secretary for schedules.

11. Any bird showing signs of contagious disease & or parasites, will be removed from the show hall, and must be picked up!

12. **Exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their birds daily during the Fair.** Food and water will be available at the show hall. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER TO SUPPLY APPROVED TYPE CONTAINERS, 2 PER CAGE, ONE FOR WATER AND ONE FOR FEED; EACH CAGE MUST HAVE 2 PROPER CONTAINERS. **Containers must be Kuhl Corporation Cup-K or equivalent as approved by the Poultry Show**

Director. Approved feed and water containers will be available for purchase in the Poultry Exhibit Barn. Birds must be checked on a daily basis and cleaned as necessary. All feed/water containers must be secured to cage sides or front corners to prevent tipping over. Even for small bantams, hook-on feeders should be on at least the second bar from the bottom to prevent soiling.

We are pleased to "freshen" feed and water in the morning, since most exhibitors cannot be present at that time. HOWEVER, each bird exhibited must be checked, either by the exhibitor or his representative daily and cleaning and feeding done as necessary. Supplies are available in the show hall. Waterfowl especially require daily feeding and cleaning. The water container should not be open enough to encourage bathing, as the bedding becomes too wet for good sanitation.

13. Waterfowl **must be cleaned on a daily basis.**

14. The SCPFA will guard against accident, loss or damage, BUT will not be liable should any occur.

15. **New Jersey State Law Requirements:** New Jersey Law requires Pullorum/typhoid testing within 30 days of exhibit in order to show or sell birds. **BE PRE-PARED TO HAVE YOUR BIRDS CHECKED FOR PULLORUM CERTIFICATES. WATERFOWL ARE EXEMPT.** All county fairs are under the auspices of New Jersey Department of Agriculture. State inspectors will be present on the fairgrounds.
